

You've stayed active through menopause. Will you be sidelined by its symptoms?



We are conducting a clinical research study to test the safety and efficacy of an investigational drug in preventing postmenopausal osteoporosis and treating menopausal symptoms while ensuring endometrial (uterine lining) safety.

You may be able to participate if you:

- Are currently 40 to 60 years old
- Have had your last menstrual cycle less than 5 years ago
- Are menopausal and experiencing menopausal symptoms
- Have not had a hysterectomy
- Have not used oral hormone treatments such as estrogen, progestin, androgen-, or SERM-containing products within the past 2 months.

Study participation lasts for approximately 14½ months. Participants can expect up to 8 visits to the study doctor. Qualified participants may receive study-related office visits, medical evaluations, mammograms, gynecological exams, bone density scans if eligible and the study drug at no cost.
